Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to the summer term. We hope you all had a good Easter break with your children and managed to have some family time and to enjoy the sunshine.



We are hoping that this term will continue on the journey back to more normal school life for our children as we also work on our recovery curriculum to help everyone begin to catch up.

Nevertheless we need to maintain our risk assessments and monitor the situation carefully, following government guidance.

As you will be aware we have made changes during the week to our collection procedures having monitored the situation outside all week. Thanks to all those who are following the rules to keep everyone safe. Here is a reminder below:

- **Please wear a face covering, unless exempt, at all times on site.**
- **Please socially distance whilst queuing or waiting for your child on the playground.**
- **Please do not arrive before 8.30am or 2.50pm and please leave the site as soon as you have collected your child.**
- **Please do not wait for friends to collect their children ,but leave promptly with your own family.**
- **Please keep all your children with you at all times and do not let any of your children, including pre-school children run off or use play equipment.**
- **If you need to speak to the teacher please wait away from the queue until everyone has collected their child to avoid causing congestion. Alternatively - write a note or email/ call the office and the teacher will get back to you.**
- **The doors will be open until 3.10pm in the afternoon if you are anxious about the numbers of people at 3.00pm and want to hold back until it is quieter.**



We will continue to be flexible where there have been lots of changes to times due to COVID rules but by half term all children will need to be in school for the whole school day. Thanks for your ongoing understanding and support.

COVID Test Reminder - We know that some of you have access to lateral flow tests at home, please be advised that lateral flow tests should ONLY be used when you are NOT showing any symptoms.

If you, your child or anyone else in your household are showing symptoms, you **MUST** book a full PCR Covid test at a test centre: <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>

We are requesting that when your child has had to isolate, that you please show the related test results, whether negative or positive to a member of the office team or email a screen shot to: adminoffice@trosnant.hants.sch.uk

Please continue to follow our COVID-19 procedures, leaving the site promptly after drop off and collection and not arriving early, socially distancing on site and wearing a face covering on site unless exempt.
