What we will be learning about?



English:

Year 6 will begin by recapping our descriptive writing skills, inspired by an animation about the Mexican Day of the Dead. We will then focus on reading strategies to help us unpick an unfamiliar text in Book Talk. Later we will use the book Holes to write a diary entry and letter, focusing on our use of inference.

Maths:

Year 6 will begin by revisiting the number system, ordering and comparing up to 7-digit numbers before consolidating addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills.
